The federal government has unveiled a \$50-million program aimed at helping small-and-medium-sized businesses develop export markets for their goods and services.



To be eligible, businesses must have fewer than 250 employees and annual revenue in Canada of between \$200,000 and \$50 million. Existing exporters are eligible if they have new products, or if they are developing new markets. Click here for details.
